Objective 1: Increase the participation of people with disabilities in social life.

Objective 2: Improve daily life for everyone. (Increase AAH by 100 €) We will reduce the poverty of people with disabilities.

Objective 3: We will improve access to employment for people with disabilities.

In France, there are 130,000 disabled workers and 500,000 people with disabilities are enrolled in Pôle emploi.

Objective 4: Make a special effort on prevention, primary care and research.

Objective 5: Helping caregivers.

We will encourage respite for caregivers.

Objective 6: Disability at the center of our action.

Systematically define inclusion indicators for each public policy. It is a question of sharing, upstream, clear and precise objectives in all fields to better evaluate, downstream, the impact of the public policies decided upon.

Emmanuel Macron and Marine Le Pen, as well as Jean Luc Melenchon, Nicolas Dupont Aignan and Francois Fillon, are the only ones who have devoted part of their presidential project to the disability. More than 500,000 disabled people are unemployed in France and suffer the double punishment of discrimination in key positions (politics, show bizz, media, and especially politics), as well as the daily difficulties. France, a country of human rights, remains one of the countries of the G20 late in the face of the deplorable situation of people with disabilities. For this reason, the "Paralyzed Association of France" had alerted the presidential candidates, and organized the march of the forgotten as well as other collectives to sound the alarm.
