THE FRENCH NATIONAL BAR COUNCIL OBTAINS PARTIAL CANCELLATION OF THE DECREE

ALLOWING CREATION OF THE GENDNOTE APP

In a resolution adopted on March 20, 2020, the National Bar Council denounced the risks of drift and misappropriation of the data collected as well as of registration the the risk of population that such an application would generate.----

On April 13, the Council of State confirmed the resolution of the National Bar Council by denouncing the risks of excesses and misappropriation of the data collected by this application. However, this victory is partial because the Council of State annulled only part of this decree, that which provides that the data can be exploited "in other treatments, in particular by the means of a system of pre -information". The National Bar Council remains fully mobilized for the protection of human rights and fundamental freedoms. Source: French National Bar
