SEC OF STATE A. BLINKEN TO TRAVEL TO PARIS TO CHAIR MINISTERIAL COUNCIL MEETING

OF THE 60TH ANNIVERSARY OECD 4-6 OCTOBER

Blinken will travel to Paris, France October 4 – 6 to chair the Ministerial Council Meeting (MCM) of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) and commemorate the organization's 60th anniversary. The U.S. delegation will include the Special Presidential Envoy for Climate, the United States Trade Representative, the Chair of the Council of Economic Advisors, and the Under Secretary for Economic Growth, Energy and the Environment.
