The United States and Albania had, previously, called for a UN Security Council vote on Friday, February 25, 2022 at 8:00 p.m. GMT on a draft resolution strongly condemning the invasion of Ukraine and calling for the immediate withdrawal of Russian troops. (The day after the Russian attack of 24th February 2022). The draft, placed under Chapter 7 of the United Nations Charter, which allows the use of force to enforce it, is doomed to failure because of the right of veto that Russia has in the Security Council as a permanent member. , according to diplomats.-----

According to the draft text, the Council would condemn "in the strongest terms Russia's aggression against Ukraine", pointing out that it violates Article 2(4) of the UN Charter. This paragraph states that "all members shall refrain in their international relations from the use of threat or force against the territorial integrity or political independence of any State".
