A TRAWLER SINKS OFF ITALIAN COAST TRAGIC TO THE IMMIGRANTS ON BOARD

700 ARE MISSING PRESUMED

USPA NEWS - The sinking of a trawler with migrants on board off the coast of Libya/Italy this weekend is dreading the "worst tragedy" of this type in the Mediterranean, with 700 missing presumed. Europe is ordered to respond by ad hoc meeting to take action to prevent such human tragedies, the gateway to Europe

These people pay the trip between 200 to 5,000 € per person to cross the Mediterranean to Europe, hoping to reach Eldorado. They come mostly from Libya, Iraq, Afghanistan, Kenya.

he Italian coast guard did not confirm the figure of 700, but state that this trawler 20-meter "has the capacity to transport hundreds of people."

The last official assessment of this new shipwreck tragedy occurred on the night from Saturday to Sunday in Libyan waters 100km) was 24 dead and 28 survivors, said the Italian coast guard, coordinating relief.
