The President Obama continues targeting the national effort needed to be made in reducing the part of polluting earth, by finding alternative energy, replacing coal by other resources eco friendly and battling emission of carbon in the atmosphere: "Today after working with states and cities and power companies, the EPA is setting the first ever nationwide standards to end the limitless dumping of carbon pollution from power plants," He continues targeting the national effort to has to be made in reducing the part of polluting earth "Washington is starting to catch up with the vision of the rest of the country."

Such measures appear to agree with the current trends which depend even the survival of some endangered species, climate disruption that causes the imbalance on some ecosystems, pollution of some rivers and water points. The plan on the climatique change could better resonate in the minds of Americans including California that is currently affected by wildfires. For as some disaster events occur in the four corners of the planet, alerting the imminence of serious ecological danger, is real. This is not a fantasy, nor a dream ...but it could become a nightmare for everyone, if nothing is done very soon.

It prevents the reactions of conservative political sides stand face to these proposals, which put them in anger when it comes to removing coal factories, which are major sources of financial revenue. WE WILL REDUCE CARBON POLLUTION FROM POWER PLANTS BY 32% BY 2030 SAID PRESIDENT OBAMA

President Obama's CLEAN POWER PLAN will reduce carbon pollution from power plants by 32% by 2030. "Power plants are the single biggest source of harmful carbon pollution that contributes to climate change," Obama said. "Until now, there have been no federal limits to the amount of carbon pollution plants dump in the air." Former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush, one of the conservative opponent in politics, who is also running for president, said on Sunday climate change "will not be solved by grabbing power from states or slowly hollowing out our economy."

In the coming weeks, Obama will travel to Nevada to speak at the National Clean Energy Summit and later become the first sitting President to go to the Alaskan Arctic.-----Press Conference at White House and CNN News
