The nine winners are as follows:

- 1. Siemens: Optilane, driver assistance optic monitoring service dedicated lanes.
- 2. SEA signaling: operation of junctions with continuous feeding.
- 3. Colas: ECOFAST, surface sealing and adhesion complex.
- 4. OTT Hydromet: Embedded real time weather sensor for monitoring the condition of roads in winter.
- 5. General Council of the North, ANAXA-VIDA: automatic sensor measures the number of occupants in vehicles.
- 6. Eiffage Travaux Publics: R6PONT, seismic reinforcement of bridges lining UHPC batteries.
- 7. Geotechnics and Special Works: Wall nailed AD / OC®.
- 8. Reinforced Earth: TERRALINKTM: strengthening solution and road widening.
- 9. Eiffage Travaux Publics: RECYCLEAN® polluted pavement recycling in place by encapsulation.
