Arrested in Madrid three suspected jihadists ready to attack

Follow the orders of DAESH

USPA NEWS - Agents of the General Information Office of the Spanish National Police arrested at dawn Tuesday in Madrid, three people of Moroccan origin residing in Spain, accused of being part of a group linked to the terrorist organization DAESH.

The arrested, aged between 26 and 29 years, they possessed weapons acquired easily, according to investigative sources. In fact, they are living in an area where it is easy to acquire weapons or drugs. To detect the intentions of the suspects, officers chose his immediate capture. Young people residing in Madrid for several years and were there "to junk and cardboard", the same sources indicate that clarify that it is not ruled out that they could finalize a joint action.

However, they had no fixed targets. They had already assimilated DAESH generic order and were willing to carry it out. "Buy a gun and act against police. Take a knife and go to a synagogue... any of the situations that have occurred in recent months in Europe could be imitated by these detainees," point sources of research cited by the Spanish press.

Police said the detainees were prepared to carry out, at any time, terrorists like those that occurred recently in other European countries acts. The operation, which is still open, has been coordinated by the head of the Central Court of Instruction No. 4 and by the Office of the High Court. Police did not rule out further arrests in the coming hours.
