NICE ATTACK IS A TERRORIST ACT OUT SAYS PRESIDENT HOLLANDE

KILLING 84 PEOPLE & SCORED INJURES

USPA NEWS - A large truck at 11: 35 pm, french time, drove in a crazy speedy way and crashed into the crowd and killed 84 people and injuring at least 202 in Nice, French Riviera. The driver was identified a Terrorist claimed by ISIS. President Hollande will chair a national defense council tomorrow in Elysee.

President Hollande addressed the nation, saying all measures are being employed to help the victims. Security measures will be increased and an existing state of emergency, which was scheduled to end later this month, will be extended three months. He said France must exhibit vigilance in the face of terrorist threats.-----

Preliminary information from French officials is that there was one individual in the truck, according to a U.S. law enforcement official briefed on the attack.------

U.S. President Barack Obama issued a statement condemning the attack and saying, "We stand in solidarity and partnership with France, our oldest ally, as they respond to and recover from this attack."

Secretary Kerry and Russian Foreign Minister Lavrov visit the French Embassy in Moscow today to sign a condolence book for the Nice attack, in Moscow, Russia, July 15, 2016.------

The Nice attack was "an attack on the terrorist nature can not be denied," said the night of Thursday to Friday the head of state. "It is France that is under the threat of Islamist terrorism," he said:"France has been hit the day of its national holiday on 14 July, symbol of freedom, because human rights are denied by the fanatics and that France is necessarily their target. "
